

Downloading Audio Books

Getting Started

Here's how to use this service:

- Visit the [Listen Up Vermont](#) web site and read the [Quick Start Guide](#). We strongly recommend reading the Quick Start Guide completely before going any further. If you don't find what you are looking for in the guide, try the [FAQ](#) section of the site.
- Download the [Overdrive Media Console](#) software that you'll need. If you have a dial-up connection, this step may take some time. In some cases you may also have to upgrade the security of your Windows Media Player. Just follow the directions to complete this process.
- [Visit the Listen Up Vermont site](#), and click the *sign in* link at the top of the page. Select **Warren Public Library** from the list of libraries. Make sure that you have your library patron number available as you will have to enter it for access.
- Search for books either using our [Online Catalog](#) or at [Listen Up Vermont](#). You may check out a maximum of two books and you can choose to check them out for seven days or fourteen days. After this period, the books will no longer be available on your computer.
- When you are ready, click the **Checkout** link to start the downloading process. You can download either an entire book or selected chapters.

Selecting Books for Downloading

You can use our [online catalog](#) to search for books. Click the book title link. If the book is downloadable, it will say “no physical items” and there will be a link marked “online resources.” Click on the link to go to the Listen Up Vermont web site. We also have downloadable audiobooks from NetLibrary.

Once you have found a book that you wish to download, check that there is an **add to basket** link indicating that the title is available for downloading. If so, click the link to add the title to your basket.
